(You can consider <i>before</i>, <i>during</i>, and <i>after</i> reading.)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Predicting</b></p> <p>Where does the author "leave you hanging," causing you to <b>predict</b> what might happen next?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Figuring Out</b></p> <p>Did you <b>figure out</b> the author's message in this text? What did the author want readers to think about?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Connecting</b></p> <p>Can you apply the author's message by <b>connecting</b> it to your own life?</p>
